DOCKET</p> <p>Any matter requiring less than 20 minutes for all parties to present (time will be equally divided among the parties)</p> <p>Matters may be removed from docket by agreement of the parties or notice by party who originally set the matter on the docket. Permission of the Court is not required.</p> <p>10:00 A.M. DOCKET</p> <p>Any matter requiring 20 min. or more for hearing - Remember to ask the clerk about the matters scheduled ahead of you. When setting cases you must tell the Clerk how long you expect your case to take. (Ex. If there are 6 cases totaling 12 expected hours ahead of you, please choose another day.) Matters may be removed from docket by agreement of the parties. Permission of the Court is not required.</p> <p><u>Any contested matter over 20 minutes can also be set as backup on any jury day.</u> You are encouraged to do so.</p>	<p>Uncontested matters of any type: default hearings, adoptions, settlement approvals, etc.</p> <p>Contested motions requiring only argument of counsel. No witness or party testimony allowed.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">i.e. Motions for Summary Judgment; Motions in Limine, Motions to Compel, etc. (no time limit)</p> <p>Matters may be removed from docket by agreement of the parties or notice by movant. Permission of the Court is not required.</p> <p>NO 10:00 A.M. DOCKET on Motion Days except for specially set matters (i.e. set by Judge)</p>
<p>To place matters on the Docket Call 931-648-5700 - Option 1</p>	<p>JURY TRIALS</p> <p>Continuances are obtained by written motion which must be timely filed and supported by sworn affidavit. Continuances must be approved by Court.</p> <p>Backup cases: Contested Cases Only (no i.d. divorces, settlements, etc.)</p>
